Professor D.K.Bihani was born on 1st July 1958 at Sangaria, Rajasthan India in a well-educated family and had a bright career since his schooling. He obtained his BVSc & AH from the University of Udaipur in 1981 and his Master's degree in 1984 from Mohanlal Sukhadia University with high merit. He obtained his doctorate in Veterinary Medicine in 2001 from the Rajasthan Agriculture University, Bikaner.

Prof. Bihani joined the department of Animal husbandry Government of Rajasthan India in 1984 and was a very popular Veterinary Assistant Surgeon among animal breeders and till his selection as an Assistant Professor in Veterinary Medicine at Rajasthan Agricultural University Bikaner he treated a large number of animals. His popularity as a clinician continued even after his new assignment and he continues to be a well-known and popular clinician.

He was the Incharge Veterinary Medicine clinic at Veterinary College Bikaner and also the Superintendent in Teaching Veterinary Clinical complex. Besides this he has worked as hostel warden of graduate and postgraduate hostels at Veterinary College Bikaner.

Prof. Bihani has long experience of working with canine patients and has remained the treasurer and joint secretary of the Canine Welfare Society for a pretty long period. He is also the Executive Editor of Journal of Canine Development and Research since the inception of the journal.
